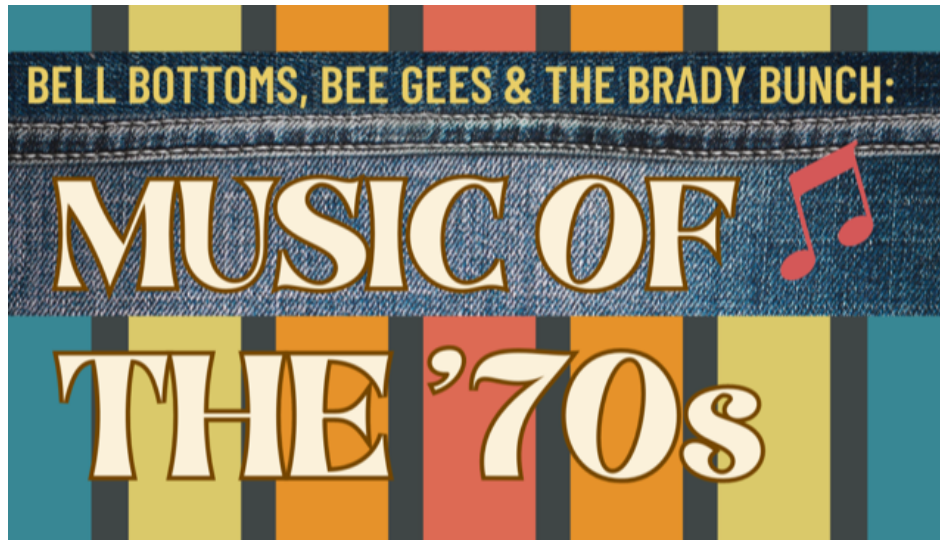

Summer Camp Scholarships

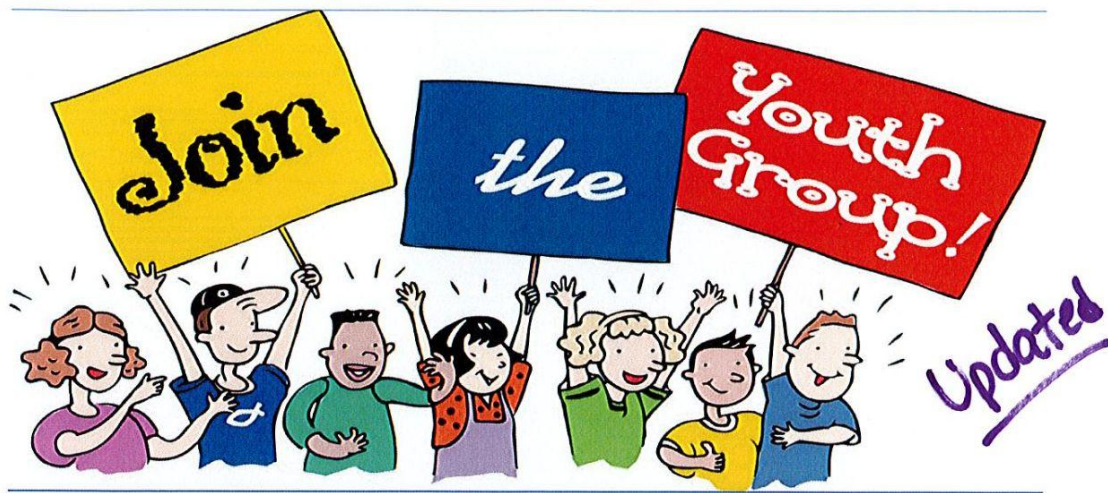

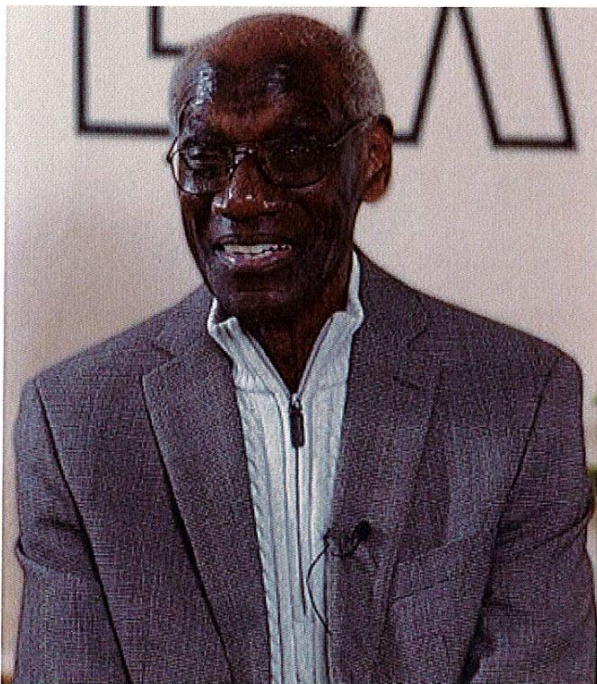
