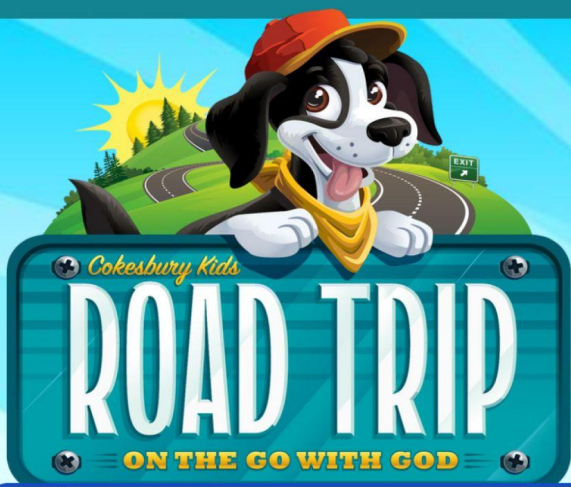


- Diane Gennaro–Mary Blanchard just found out she has an aggressive form of stomach cancer

- Wendi Rybicki–Traveling mercies for our congregation



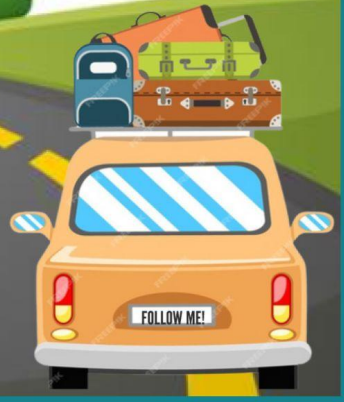
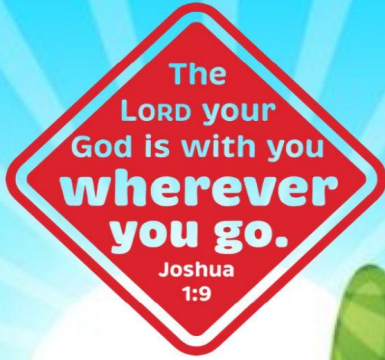

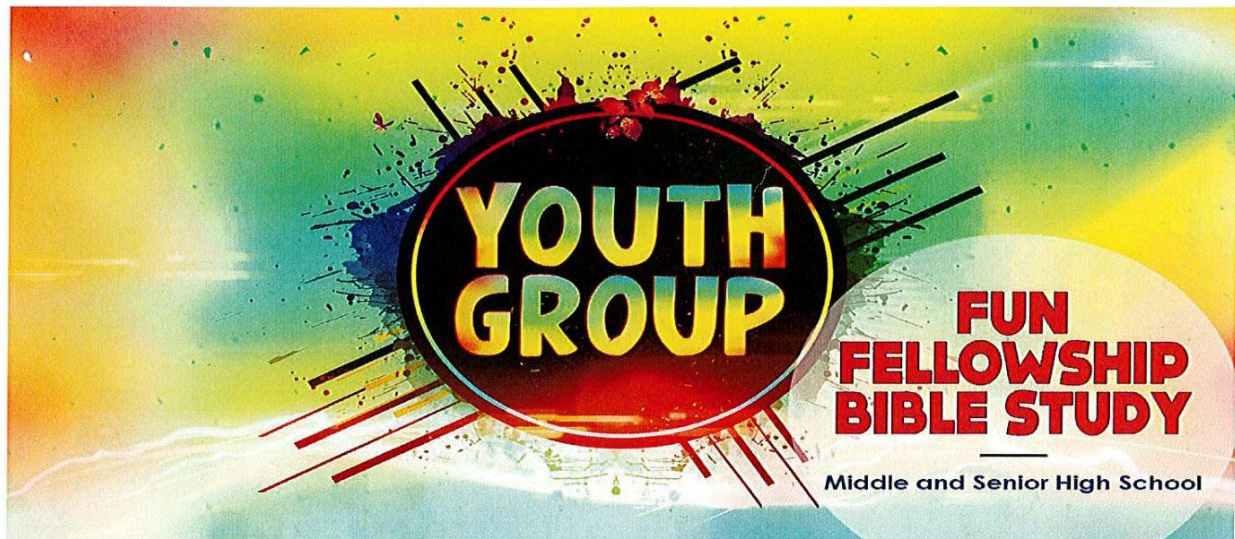
